ORDINANCE AMENDING CURFEW  
RESTRICTIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF HOMER

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer, Illinois is a duly established and functioning municipality in Champaign County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Village of Homer did heretofore enact a Village Code of Homer, Illinois 1985, as amended, which Code remains in effect; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 5-1 of said Village Code of Homer is entitled "Minors," and Section 5.1.1 therein is entitled Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homer determined that said ordinance should be amended to better define curfew violations and exemptions therefor based on recent court decisions; and

WHEREAS, the fines presently defined in effect for curfew violations are considered inadequate by the Village Board of Trustees and should be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. of said Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen years to be upon any public way in the Village of Homer between the hours of 12:01 a.m. Saturday and 6:00 a.m. Sunday, or between the hours of 12:01 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on holidays and non-school days, or between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any other days unless accompanied by and in charge of a parent, guardian or other proper companion of the age of twenty-one years or more, or unless engaged in some occupation or business in which such child may lawfully engage under the statutes of this state.

Provided however if said underage person is coming to or from a religious or political event which events are excepted from curfew regulation by court decision, then such conduct is not a violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. FINES

Any police officer or Village Trustee finding a child violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall warn the child to desist immediately from such violation and shall cause a written notice to be served upon the parent, guardian or person in charge of such child, setting forth the manner in which this Ordinance has been violated. Any parent, guardian or person in charge of such child who shall knowingly permit such child again to violate this Ordinance after receiving notice of the first violation shall be fined not less than \$150.00 nor more than \$450.00 for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, that determination shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the other provisions of this ordinance, unless the determination of invalidity so requires.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be Oct. 20, 2005.

SECTION 5. PUBLICATION

Publication of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the Village Clerk, in accordance with law.


