ORDINANCE NO. 2006- 5-08-06

ORDINANCE AMENDING SELECTED PENALTY
PROVISIONS OF HOMER VILLAGE CODE

ADOPTED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF HOMER ON
MAY 08, 2006

Published in pamphlet form by the authority of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homer, Champaign County, Illinois, this 9TH day of MAY, 2006.

Section 2. Section 4.3.1 of the Homer Village Code, entitled “Offensive Premises”, is hereby amended by deleting the words:

“a fine or penalty of not less than three dollars (\$3.00) and not exceeding twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each offense and an additional penalty of one dollar (\$1.00) for each day he shall so neglect to abate, remove, remedy or cleanse the same after issuance of such notice”.

And substituting therefor the words:

“a fine or penalty of not less than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) and not exceeding four hundred fifty dollars (\$450.00) for each offense and each day that said condition continues shall be deemed a separate offense for which a separate fine is imposable”.

Section 3. Section 4.3.4 of the Homer Village Code entitled “Abatement of Nuisance”, is hereby amended by deleting the words:

“a fine not less than three dollars (\$3.00) and not exceeding twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense”.

And substituting therefor the words:

“a fine of not less than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) and not exceeding four hundred fifty dollars (\$450.00) for each offense.

Section 4. Section 8.1.2 F. of the Homer Village Code entitled “Penalties” is amended by deleting the words:

“a penalty of not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for each and every day or part of a day such owner may permit suffer such building to remain”

And substituting therefor the words:

“A penalty of not less than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) and not more than four hundred fifty dollars (\$450.00) for each and every day such owner may permit or suffer such building to remain”

Section 5. Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, that determination shall not effect the validity or enforceability of the other provisions of this ordinance, unless the determination of invalidity so requires.

Section 6. Effective Date.


The effective date of this Ordinance shall be June 01, 2006.

Publication of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the Village Clerk, in accordance with law.




